Beech tree threat tracked

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) announced Beech Leaf Disease (BLD), which affects all species of beech trees, has been identified in 35 counties in New York to date. DEC began tracking BLD in 2018 after it was confirmed in Chautauqua County. Fourteen of the counties with BLD were confirmed in 2022, and more are likely to be identified.

Much is still unknown about BLD, including how it spreads, but it can kill mature beech trees in six to 10 years and saplings in as little as two years. There is no known treatment for infected trees. BLD symptoms are associated with the nematode Litylenchus

crenatae mccannii. It is unknown whether the nematode causes all of the damage, or if it is in association with another pathogen such as a virus, bacteria, or fungus.

DEC is working with the Cornell Plant Disease Diagnostic Clinic, the U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service, neighboring states, and New York's Partnerships for Regional Invasive Species Management (PRISMs) to survey for new infections, track disease progression using long-term monitoring plots, and investigate the nematode's role in the disease. More information is needed to develop an effective treatment.

DEC is asking the public

to submit reports through NYInvasives if they encounter a beech tree showing signs of BLD, especially for counties where BLD has not yet been confirmed.

The main symptom on beech foliage is darkened striping between the veins, which is best seen when looking up through the canopy. Leaves with severe symptoms can be heavily banded and crinkled, with a thickened leathery texture.

Sidney Center playground dedicated to Josh Newell

SIDNEY CENTER - Bright sunshine and blue skies shone for a Sidney Center park dedication and celebration in Sidney Center on July 3. It was a celebration of the revitalization of the park.

The park, which fell into disuse after repeated flooding which required mitigation, became a special project for the Sidney Center Improvement Group (SCIG). It was especially dear to the heart of group member Josh Newell who grew up playing in the Sidney Center Park. He had a vision of his children and other children being able to enjoy the park the way he had in his youth. His enthusiasm led the group to

move forward on the project in the fall of 2017.

Newell died, succumbing to leukemia, before he could see his dream come to fruition. During the dedication ceremony, SCIG President Michael Sellitti dedicated the playground in the park to Newell; a plaque will be installed there in his honor.

The celebration also included the unveiling of the 56-foot mural created by local artists. When the mural was unveiled it received a mixture of applause, exclamations and stunned silence. The sheer creativity and beauty of panels brought some to tears.

The mural, "Sidney Center Blooms," was spearheaded by local artist Vicki Davis. The panels depict local plants and animal species and are unique to each artist or group of artists that completed them. Professional artists Caroline Fay, Jody Isaacson and Kieko Howard each con-

tributed panels as did the Arc of Delaware County Studio 190, students in the Franklin School Art Club and Sidney Central School art students.

Davis designed the final panel, but left it for the community to paint. People waited patiently in line to help complete the mural. Children painted with parents, high school students added their special touches and community members stepped up to bring color to the final panel. It was a highlight of the event.

Davis also created fish sculptures that were displayed in the creek bed during the event that invited people to stroll along the water's edge to enjoy the varied mediums and colors of her creations.

The event attracted people from far and near. Sidney Supervisor Eric Wilson and Councilmembers Frank Selleck and William Hunt, Jr. also attended the event. Family members traveled from out of town to support the community they know and love, and members of the SCIG worked tirelessly to make sure the event went off without a hitch.

While the playground equipment, new benches and tables had not yet been installed, the progress already made to re-

store and improve the park was something to celebrate and is a testament to a small community with a big heart.

Avocados are packed with nutrients and vitamins



Avocados are beloved by foodies, particularly those who enjoy guacamole. But flavor is not the only reason to love avocados, which the Cleveland Clinic notes are good sources of these nutrients and vitamins.

- **Potassium:** Though bananas often are touted for their potassium, the Cleveland Clinic reports that avocados contain more of this heart-healthy essential mineral than bananas. Potassium helps to control blood pressure and promotes a healthy heart.
- **Vitamin C:** The health care experts at Cedars Sinai note that avocados are a great source of vitamin C. What's more, Cedars Sinai reports that avocados help the body absorb nutrients, allowing it to utilize them more effectively.
- **Fiber:** High fiber diets provide a host of benefits, as fiber helps to lower blood sugar and reduce bad cholesterol. Cedars Sinai estimates that one avocado contains around 10 grams of fiber, which is roughly half the recommended daily fiber intake for women and nearly one-third the recommended intake for men.

Despite their high nutrient content, avocados should be consumed in moderation. That's because the Cleveland Clinic notes that a single avocado can contain upward of 400 calories.



How to conserve energy while keeping the AC on

Air conditioning is a welcome luxury come the dog days of summer. Few people can imagine getting through a hot summer afternoon without turning their AC on, and that can make July and August some of the more costly months on the calendar in regard to energy consumption.

Though the months of July and August may not seem well-suited to cutting energy consumption, there are ways to conserve that don't require turning off the AC.

- **Reconsider the location of your thermostat.** The Performance Building Institute, Inc. notes that thermostats are sensitive to heat. Thermostats located near heat-generating appliances like lamps, televisions and computers may be fooled into thinking a home's interior is warmer than it actually is. That will keep a temperature-controlled AC running longer and more frequently than is necessary. If necessary, move the thermostat to a part of the home where there are no electronics and appliances.
- **Emphasize maintenance of the AC unit.** Even the most energy-efficient AC unit will be forced to work harder, and consume extra energy, if it's not well-maintained. The Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy notes that ENERGY STAR-certified HVAC equipment can yield annual energy savings of 10 to 30 percent. But such products must be maintained. Annual maintenance appointments with an HVAC technician can ensure the unit is clean and refrigerant levels are correct, helping it run as efficiently as possible.
- **Embrace natural ways to keep a home's interior cool.** Cranking the AC is not the only way to maintain a comfortable temperature inside a home during the months of July and August. Closing curtains on especially warm days keeps the sun out and makes it easier to maintain comfortable temperatures inside without lowering the temperature on the thermostat. Avoiding the stove on hot nights and preparing cold meals or firing up the grill outside is another way to keep the house cool.
- **Address insulation issues.** Cracks around windows and doors affect the temperature inside the home, making it colder in winter and warmer in summertime. Seal cracks around doors and windows to keep the cool air in during the summer. Keeping that air in should allow you to raise the temperature on your thermostat without compromising comfort.

Come the dog days of summer, conserving energy needn't come at the cost of comfort. Various strategies can help people reduce their energy consumption and keep their air conditioners on.

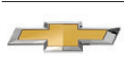
